

Course Outline of Japanese Language Extension Activities 2010-2011

Bangalore Nihongo Kyooshikai (BNK) in collaboration with Bangalore University offers "Japanese Language Extension Activities" at the Department of Foreign Languages, Bangalore University. This programme covers a variety of activities by which students can have more opportunities to get acquainted with Japanese language and cultures in different ways according to their interest and needs. The outlines of respective activities for the Academic Year 2010-11 are given here.

1. JLPT N4 Prep. (July – November 2010 only)

This course aims at supplementing Diploma Course at the University or equivalent courses at other institutions to prepare for the Level N4 JLPT test to be held on 5th December, 2010. The activities are focused on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern and developing your ability to apply your Japanese knowledge to actual communication as well as acquiring Japanese Language knowledge.

Capacity: Mini. 10, max. 15 students. Frequency: 2hours each on Saturdays/Sundays.

Eligibility: BNK members, preferably those who have passed N5 or L4 JLPT. (Studying at this course only may not enough to fully prepare for the Level N4 JLPT.)

Tuition: Rs. 5,500 for throughout the course (Excluding cost of materials).

2. JLPT N3 Prep. (July.-November. 2010 only)

This course aims at supplementing Higher Diploma Course at the University to prepare for the Level N3 JLPT test to be held on 5th December, 2010. (It does not aim at fully preparing for the test by this course only.) The activities are focused on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern and developing your ability to apply your Japanese knowledge to actual communication as well as acquiring Japanese Language knowledge.

Capacity: Mini.10, max. 15 students. Frequnecy: 2 hours each on Saturdays and Sundays.

Eligibility: BNK members preferably those who have passed N4 or L3 and are Studying at Higher Diploma Course at Bangalore University or equivalent courses at other institutions.

Tuitions: Rs. 6,000 for throughout the course (excluding cost of materials).

3. JLPT N2 Prep. (Jul.-Nov. 2010 only)

This course aims at supplementing Higher/Advance diploma Course at the University to prepare for the Level N2 JLPT test to be held on 5th December, 2009. (It does not aim at preparing for the test by this course only.) The activities are focused on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern and developing your ability to apply your Japanese knowledge to actual communication as well as acquiring Japanese Language knowledge.

Capacity: Mini.10, max. 15 students. Frequency: 2 hours each on Saturdays and Sundays.

Eligibility: BNK members, preferably those who have passed N3 and are studying at Higher Diploma/Advance Diploma Course at Bangalore University or elsewhere.

Tuition: Rs. 6,500 for throughout the course (Excluding cost of materials).

4. JLPT L1 Prep. (July – November, 2010 only)

This activity aims at supplementing self-study of those students who attempt to take Level N1 JLPT test to be held on 5th December, 2010. (It does not aim at preparing fully for the test by studying at this course only.) The activities are focused on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern on getting accustomed with JLPT pattern and developing your ability to apply your Japanese knowledge to actual communication as well as acquiring Japanese Language knowledge.

Capacity: Mini.10, max.15 students. Frequency: 2 hours on Sundays and Sundays.

Eligibility:BNK members preferably those who have passed Level N2 JLPT and/or are studying Japanese by oneself or at some institutions at an Advanced level.

Tuition: Rs. 7,000 for throughout the course (Excluding cost of materials)

5. Business Japanese (January, 2011 – March, 2011 only)

This course aims at learning Japanese language in business context along with business customs and working culture in Japan.

Capacity: Mini.10, Max. 15 students. Frequency: 2 hours each on Saturdays and Sundays.

Eligibility: BNK members, preferably those who passed JLPT L3/N3 and are using or going to use Japanese at workplace are preferable.

Tuition: Rs. 5,000 (Excluding cost of materials.)

6. Writing & Speech (July 2010 – March 2011)

This course aims at learning and practice how to compose different writings, and to make speeches in a variety of topics. This may supplement regular Japanese courses for developing your skills of writing and delivering speech in Japanese in particular. Those who intend to participate in the Japanese Speech Contests and Japanese Essay Contest are recommended to join this course.

Capacity: Mini.5, max.15 students. Frequency: 2 hours on Thursday.

Eligibility: BNK members, preferably those who have learned Japanese for longer than 3 months.

Tuition: Rs. 5,000 (Excluding cost of materials)

7. Japanese Calligraphy Course (June 2010 – January 2011)

This course is newly introduced for those who are interested in Japanese Calligraphy and are eager to learn how to write Japanese characters properly. Starting with writing by a ballpoint pen, one will learn from native Japanese how Japanese characters are written properly and beautifully by brushes

Capacity: Min.5, max.15 students. **Frequency:** 2 hours (11:00 am – 1:00 pm) on Mondays.

Eligibility: BNK members, whoever is interested in Japanese Calligraphy and writing characters.

Tuition: Rs.5,000 (**Including cost of materials**)

8. MEXT Prep. Course (July 2010-Feb 2011)

This course is meant for those who are challenging to take an exam for Monbukagakushoo Nikkensei Test to be conducted around mid. March, 2011 for studying Japanese language and other subjects at a university in Japan for one year under Japanese government scholarship programme.

Capacity: Maximum 5 students only. Frequency: 2hous on Tuesdays.

Eligibility: Student learning Japanese at the university courses, whose age is less than 30 years old. (Excluding cost of materials)
