- A: Admission : Opens on **Jul/10**, 2010 and Closed on **Jul/31**, 2010.
- B: Entrance Exam(Transfer Students only): 9:00-11:00 am on **Jul/18 (Sun)** or **Jul/31(Sat)**  
<Note: Transfer Students: Those students who did not pass the lower level of Japanese course at this department of Bangalore University.>
- C: Duration : Aug/2, 2010 – March/April, 2011 (8 months, about 150 hours).  
Inaugural on Aug/2 (Mon), classes start from Aug/3(Tue), 2010.  
Weekday Course: 100minutes X 3 (300minutes=5 hours/week).  
Weekend Course: 2 hours on Sat. + 3 hours on Sun. (5hours/week)
- D: Exams : Midterm Exam. (Dec. 2010), Final Exam. (Apr. 2011)
- E: Faculty : 5 instructors (2 Japanese and 3 Indian)

## 1. Certificate Course in Japanese (Weekday Evening & Weekend)

- (1) Eligibility : Pass in P. U. C. II year
- (2) Textbook : “Minna no Nihongo” Vol. 1 published by Three A Network and other supplementary materials
- (3) Scheme of Examination:

(c) Pass in the Level 4 (N5) of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), and pass in an Entrance Exam (see above B).

(b) Pass in a course equivalent to Diploma Course at this Dept. in other universities (e.g. JNU, U of D, Pune Univ. , Viswa Bharati, EFLU,etc.) and pass in the Entrance Exam (see above B.)  
or (c) Pass in the Level 3 of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) and pass in the Entrance Exam (see above B.).
