Eligibility conditions for admission to Post-Graduate Science Courses for the Academic Year 2011-2012.

Minimum Eligibility requirements for admission to the Master Degree Courses in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Anthropology, Geology and Environmental Studies through Entrance Examination are as Under:-

1. M. Sc. Course in Physics:

EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Physics (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose examination is recognized as equivalent to University of Delhi and fulfil other conditions of eligibility.

Intake capacity: 147

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

50% or above marks in aggregate both main and subsidiary (integrated) and 50% or above marks in Physics.

OR

B.Sc. (General/Programme/B.Sc. (Pass) B.Sc. (H) Electronic, B.A. Sc. (H) Instrumentation B.A. Sc. (H) Electronics (3 Years Course) after (10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose examination is recognized as equivalent to Delhi University and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

60% or above marks in the aggregate and 60% or above marks in Physics.

OR

Any branch of Science or Engineering with Physics and Mathematics as two of the Subjects of study.

60% or above marks in the aggregate and 60% or above marks in Physics.

- **NOTE:** 1. A candidate passing B.Sc. (Hons.) Physics as main subject must have passed Mathematics and Chemistry/Statistics/Geology/Electronics/Computer Science as subsidiary/ancillary subjects.
 - 2. A candidate who wishes to be admitted to M.Sc. course in Physics must have passed B.Sc. (Genl)/(Pass) Examination with either of the following combination:
 - (a). Physics, Maths and Chemistry
 - (b). Physics, Maths and Statistics.
 - (c). Physics, Maths and Geology.
 - (d). Physics, Maths and Electronics.
 - (e). Physics, Maths and Computer Science.

2. M. Sc. Course in Chemistry:

EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Chemistry (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose examination is recognized as equivalent to University of Delhi and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

Intake capacity: 139

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

B.Sc. (Hons. Chemistry with 50% or above marks in aggregate and 50% or above marks in Chemistry Candidate must have passed 10+2 (Senior Secondary) or equivalent examination recognized by the University of Delhi and B.Sc. (Hons.) Chemistry examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects.

OR

B.Sc. (Genl.)/B.Sc. (Pass)/B.Sc. (Prog.) (3 years course after 10+2)

B.Sc. (Gen./Programme) with 60% or above marks in aggregate and 60% or above marks in Chemistry.

from Delhi University or any other University whose examinations are recognized as equivalent to Delhi University and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

3. M. Sc. Course in Botany: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Botany/B.Sc. (Hons.) Biological Science (3Years Courses after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose examination is recognized as equivalent to University of Delhi and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

Candidate must have passed 10+2 (Senior Secondary) or equivalent examination recognized by the University of Delhi and B.Sc. (Genl.)/B.Sc. (Pass)/B.Sc. (Prog.) examination with Mathematics as one of the Subjects.

Intake capacity: 39

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

50% or above marks in aggregate & 50% or above marks in Botany.

OR

B.Sc. (Genl./Prog)/B.Sc. (Pass)/B.Sc. Life Science (3 Years course after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose Examination is recognized as equivalent to Delhi University and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

60% or above marks in aggregate and 60% or above marks in Botany.

- **NOTE:** 1. A candidate must have passed B.Sc. (Genl). examination with Botany, Chemistry and Zoology/Environmental Science at the qualifying examination.
 - 2. A candidate passing Botany (Honours) examination must have passed any two out of Chemistry and Zoology and Environmental Science as subsidiary/ ancillary subject at the last qualifying examination.

4. M. Sc. Course in Zoology:

EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Zoology/B.Sc. (Hons.) Biological Science (3 Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose examination is recognized as equivalent to University of Delhi and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

Intake capacity: 46

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

50% or above marks in aggregate & 50% or above marks in Zoology.

OR

B.Sc.(Hons.)/B.Sc. (Pass)/B.Sc. Life Science (3 Years course after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose examination is recognized as equivalent to Delhi University and fulfill other conditions of eligibility. 60% or above marks in aggregate and 60% or above marks in Zoology.

- **NOTE:** 1. A candidate must have passed B.Sc. (Genl.) Examination with Chemistry, Botany and Zoology at the qualifying examination.
 - 2. A candidate passing Zoology (Honours) Examination must have Chemistry and Botany as his/her subsidiary/ancillary subject at the last qualifying examination.

5. M. Sc. Course in Anthropology: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Anthropology (3 Years Course after (10+2) from University of Delhi or any other University whose examination is recongnized by the University of Delhi as equivalent and fulfill other conditions of eligibility

OR

B.Sc. /B.A. in Anthropology from any other University whose examination is recongnized by the University of Delhi as equivalent and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

OR

B.Sc.(H) / B.Sc. (General), B.A. (H)/B.A. (Pass) with Anthropology as one of the subjects from any other University whose examination is recongnized by the University of Delhi as equivalent and fulfil other conditions of eligibility.

OR

B.Sc. (H) in Botany/Zoology/Geology or B.A. (H) in Sociology/Psychology or B.Sc. (General) with both Botany and Zoology from University of Delhi or any other University whose examination is recognized by the University of Delhi as equivalent and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

6. M. Sc. Course in Geology: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Geology (3 Years course after 10+2) from Delhi University or any other University whose Examination is recognized by the University of Delhi as equivalent and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

OR

B.Sc.(Genl.)/B.Sc. (Pass) (3 Years course) with Geology, after 10+2 from Delhi University or any other University whose Examination is recognized by the University of Delhi as equivalent and fulfill other conditions of eligibility.

Intake capacity: 23

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

50% or above marks in Aggregate and 50% or above marks in Anthropology.

60% or above marks in Aggregate.

60% or above marks in Aggregate and 60% or above marks in Anthropology.

60% or above marks in Aggregate.

Intake capacity: 16

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

50% or above marks in aggregate & 50% or above marks in Geology.

- NOTE: 1. A candidate must have passed B.Sc. (Genl.) Examination with Geology and combination of any two of the following subjects: Physics/Chemistry/Maths/Botany/Zoology/Environmental Science/ Geography (besides Geology).
 - 2. A candidate who has passed B.Sc. (Hons.) Examination from University other than Delhi University where the marks of subsidiary/ancillary subjects are added in the overall result and percentage, the candidate should have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate.

Candidate should have passed any two of the ancillary/subsidiary subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Environmental Science, Geography (besides Geology).

Any undergraduate (B.A./B.Sc./ B.A.Sc. (H) B.Com Hons./Pass Course) (3 years course after 10+2) from University of Delhi or any other University whose Examination is recognized as equivalent and fulfill other conditions of eligibility, but having at least one of these subjects (Physics / Chemistry / Biology / Maths / Geography / Economics) at 10+2 level.

OR

B.Tech. Degree from any other University/Institution recognized by UGC/AICTEE.

55% or above marks in aggregate.

B.Sc. (Hons.) Physics (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University only.

2. M. Sc. Course in Chemistry: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Chemistry (3 years course after 10+2) from University of Delhi only.

B.Sc. (Programme) (3 years course after 10+2) from University of Delhi only with chemistry as one of the main subjects.

3. M. Sc. Course in Botany: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Botany (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University only.

4. M. Sc. Course in Zoology: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Zoology/ Applied Zoology (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University only.

5. M. Sc. Course in Anthropology: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Anthropology (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University only.

6. M. Sc. Course in Geology: EXAMINATION

B.Sc. (Hons.) Geology (3Years Course after 10+2) from Delhi University only.
