Further, all the authors whose abstracts are accepted for presentation will be invited for the submission of full length paper latest by November, 20, 2011 to publish in 'International Multidisciplinary Research Journal' with nominal handling charges to be paid after acceptance. The authors may give their choice at the time of submission abstract in registration form whether they wish to publish the full length paper in this journal. The papers submitted for publication in this journal will be reviewed by the competent reviewers and the authors will be notified in due course of time of the outcome of the evaluation and for further necessary process.
