to gain Research Experience in Germany**

This programme provides Bachelor-students in their 3rd and 4th years with the opportunity to spend **a minimum of 2 month** and **a maximum of 3 months** working with German doctoral students, scientists or professors on research projects at institutions of higher education and research institutes in Germany. The German hosts will help the students integrate directly into the lab work and serve as personal and professional mentors.

German language skills are not required for most positions but would be helpful for day to day life outside the laboratory. The working language will be English.

What are the benefits of this programme?

This programme will be of benefit to everyone involved. In an international context it will provide mutual academic and cultural enrichment for both the students and their hosts.

The students will:

- gain theoretical and practical research experience
- learn about Germany in an intercultural setting
- begin learning German

The German hosts will:

- receive assistance with their research projects
- increase their knowledge of the Indian culture and higher education system
- improve their English language skills.

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must:

- be full-time students at recognised Indian universities(see list below).
- have above average marks (minimum 70 % or CGPA min. 3.5 out of 4.0 OR 7.5 out of 10)
- be resident in India.
- have an invitation letter from the German host.

Application Checklist:

***3* print-outs of the application submitted online with a passport-size photograph attached to each form. Please ensure that you have duly signed all the forms before sending them to us.**

*** *3 *typed copies of full curriculum-vitae (bio-data)**

*** *3* copies of letter of motivation from the student**

*** *3 *copies of certificate of enrolment (see the attached ZAV form) which needs to be filled by the student and attested by his parent University**

*** *3 *copies of the application form, Form – Applicant to be filled by the student**

*** *3 *copies of the Form-German Host to be filled and signed by the German Professor**

*** *3 *copies of the invitation from the German host including a summary of the**

research project in which the candidate will be placed.

*** *1 *reference from senior academic mentor. The referee's title and academic status should be *clearly *indicated in this (with official rubber-stamp). These should be *CONFIDENTIAL (in sealed envelopes) and should be recent-dated ***

*** *3 *copies of university/ college certificates and mark-sheets (all copies must be attested; attested English translation, if the originals are in Hindi; PHOTOCOPIES MUST ALSO BE ATTESTED !**

Terms of Award

The DAAD will provide

- a monthly scholarship of **650 EUR** to cover living expenses,
- health-, accident- and personal liability insurance,
- a lump sum travel subsidy of **600 EUR** .

Please note:

- the scholarship duration is for a minimum of 2 months and a maximum of 3 months.
- the duration of the internship may not exceed 90 days.
- If more than one internship in Germany is planned, the total period of all internships may not exceed 12 months.
- the current limit for additional income is 400 Euros per month. If your income is in excess of 400 Euros per month this will be deducted from your scholarship award.
- the monthly instalment will be calculated on a daily basis.
- private companies can not be considered under this programme as a German host.

Accommodation :

Please ask the international office at your German host university and the German supervisor for assistance in looking for accommodation. Normally the rental agreement will commence on the first day of the month and end on the last day of the month. Therefore it is sometimes necessary to have to pay the rent for a full month even if you arrive/depart in the middle of that month.

- **30.11.2008 application deadline at the DAAD Office in New Delhi**
- **15.01.2009 Candidates will be notified of the outcome of their application.**

- **3** typed copies of full curriculum-vitae (bio-data)
- **3** copies of letter of motivation from the student
- **3** copies of certificate of enrolment (see attached)
- **3** copies of the invitation from the German host including a summary of the research project in which the candidate will be placed.
- **1** reference from senior academic mentor. The referee's title and academic status should be **clearly** indicated in this (with official rubber-stamp). These should be **CONFIDENTIAL (in sealed envelopes) and should be recent-dated**
- **3** copies of university/ college certificates and mark-sheets (all copies must be attested; attested English translation, if the originals are in Hindi; PHOTOCOPIES MUST ALSO BE ATTESTED !

The contact between the Indian students and German hosts must be established on a bilateral basis, prior to the application deadline.

The DAAD will arrange for a work permit waiver for the period of the internship with the competent authority in Germany.
