RULES FOR ENTRY: (QUIZ, SCIENCE MODEL, PAINTING & DECLAMATION)

Event No. 1: SCIENCE QUIZ COMPETITION

1. The competition is open to 2 (two) students from the same school/college currently reading in Class XI Science – Bachelor Degree in Science/Technology.
2. Entry fee is Rs. 50/- on cash payment at the MASTEC Office only.
3. There is no limit to the number of entry from one school/college. Any number of teams can join the Competition.
4. The team members once entered cannot be changed.
5. The competition will be on the topics ;
 - Groundwater – towards sustainable use
 - Hazards – minimising risk, maximising awareness
 - Earth & Health – building a safer environment
 - Climate – the ‘stone tape’
 - Resources – towards sustainable use
 - Deep Earth – from crust to core
 - Soils – the living skin of the Earth
 - Earth & Life – origins of diversity
6. 4 (four) best teams will be selected for the final round after a preliminary written test.
7. The preliminary written test will be held on **14th May, 2008 at 11.00 a.m.** and the final round will be held on **14th May, 2008 at 2.00 p.m.**
8. There will be various rounds in the final competition comprising of oral, audio, visual etc.
9. The Quiz Master’s decision on any answer will be the final and binding.

Event No. 2: SCIENCE MODEL COMPETITION

1. The Competition is open to students currently reading in Class VIII – XII Science.
2. The model can be the work of an individual or a group of 2 members. In case of teamwork the members of the team should be from the same school.
3. Entry fee is Rs. 30/- for individual and Rs. 50/- for team on cash payment at the MASTEC Office only.
4. The number of entry from one school/college will be limited to 5 (five) only.
5. The models should be based on the sub-themes;
 - Groundwater – towards sustainable use
 - Hazards – minimising risk, maximising awareness
 - Earth & Health – building a safer environment
 - Resources – towards sustainable use
 - Deep Earth – from crust to core
 - Earth & Life – origins of diversity
6. The model should be submitted at the venue of the Science Meet at **3.00 p.m. of 10th May, 2008** for necessary display arrangements. **Summary/Abstract** of the Model should also be submitted.
7. The Title of the Model along with the names of the Student(s) and Guide Teacher must be displayed properly.
8. There shall be a daily evaluation of the models by internal judges. The evaluation will be based on the quality of the model, proper display, maintenance and art of presentation to the visitors by the model exhibitors.
9. The final evaluation of the models will be held on **14th May, 2008 from 12.00 noon onwards** by performing a brief demonstration to the Judges. Guide Teachers are requested to be with the students on this day.
10. Construction cost of the model will be refunded.

Event No. 3: SPOT PAINTING COMPETITION

1. The competition is open to individual students.
2. There will be 3 (three) groups: Sub-Junior (Class III–V), Junior (Class VI–VIII) and Senior (Class IX – XII).
3. Entry fee is Rs. 30/- on cash payment at the MASTEC Office only.
4. The students may select any one of the following topics;
 - Hazards – minimising risk, maximising awareness
 - Earth & Health – building a safer environment
 - Resources – towards sustainable use
 - Earth & Life – origins of diversity
5. The painting should be with Crayon/Wax Colour for the Sub-Junior Group and with Water Colour for Junior and Senior Groups.
6. The participants should bring his/her full set of equipments. Drawing paper of size (14"x22") will be supplied to all the participants.
7. The Painting Competition will be held on **12th May, 2008 at 11.00 a.m.**

Event No. 4: DECLAMATION CONTEST

1. The contest is open to individual students currently reading in Class XI Science–Degree in Science/Technology
2. Entry fee is Rs. 30/- on cash payment at the MASTEC office only.
3. There is no limit to the number of entry from one school/college.
4. The declamation will be on any one of the following topics;
 - Groundwater – towards sustainable use
 - Hazards – minimising risk, maximising awareness
 - Earth & Health – building a safer environment
 - Soils – the living skin of the Earth
 - Resources – towards sustainable use
 - Deep Earth – from crust to core
 - Earth & Life – origins of diversity
5. Only 5 (five) contestants shall be selected for the final round through a written test at **11.00 a.m. of 13th May, 2008**
6. Students can use Slide/Power Point Presentation in the Final Round.
7. Each oral presentation will be for 7 minutes either in English or Manipuri.
8. The Final Contest will be held on **13th May, 2008 at 3.00 p.m.**

Event No. 5: BEST APPRECIATION AWARD

1. This award is open to the student visitors and participants of Science Meet – 2008.
2. The winner will be decided by judging his/her degree of appreciation of the activities and suggestive comments on the programme through written and oral tests.
3. No Entry Fee.
4. The written test will be held on **15th May, 2008 at 9.30 a.m.** and the final oral test at **12.00 noon on 15th May, 2008.**
