ELIGIBILITY:

A Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Architecture, Management, Physical Sciences, Geography, Planning, Law, or Social Sciences, with some inclination towards habitat related issues/ sectors.

Note:

1. A Bachelor's Degree of candidate must be of a minimum three years duration or its equivalent (under the pattern 10+2+3 Or 10+2+4 or 10+2+2+1 year bridge course pattern of study or any other pattern fulfilling the mandatory requirements of 15 years formal education) from a recognized University.
2. Candidates who will complete all the requirements of their final year Bachelor's Degree examinations by Saturday, June 20, 2009. In such cases, admission to any of the Master's Degree Programmes of the Institute will be provisional. If a provisionally admitted student fails in the final year examination, the offer of provisional admission automatically stands cancelled.

RESERVATION: Government of India norms will be applicable for admission of SC, ST, OBC, persons with Disability (PWD) and International Students. Only limited number of hostel seats and scholarships are available.

Selection procedure: Selection will be through written test and an interview for candidates who qualify in the written test.
