

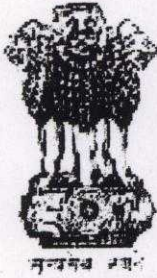

Through the GLEP, SNUT plans to invite qualified high school graduates from your country through your supervision and recommendation, especially in engineering areas, and offer opportunities to receive cutting edge undergraduate education at SNUT. The selected students with adequate qualifications will be granted tuition waivers for the whole of the undergraduate years and on-campus dormitory fees. In addition, they will have opportunities to work paid part-time jobs on campus.

SNUT is taking fast and great strides toward becoming one of the top-tier engineering universities in Korea. In Seoul, SNUT has been selected as the sole official participant in the industry-Academia Partnership University Project, which is jointly operated by the Ministry of Commerce, Industry and Energy, Ministry of Education and Human Resources Development, and Presidential Committee on Balanced National Development. This project will culminate in the construction of the Techno Park, an academia-industry complex with the state of art technology and an estimated budget of US\$500million. The complex will be completed by the end of 2007.

Global Leaders Education Program (GLEP) at Seoul National University of Technology

● Overview

Educational opportunities at SNUT for outstanding individuals from the selected countries to enhance international understanding and cooperation.

● Applicable Nations and Scholarships:

Initially 1 person from each country per each year with the possibility of increasing the number by 2 by 2013.

Region	Countries (11 in total)
Southeast Asia	Vietnam, India, Thailand, Myanmar, the Philippines, and Bangladesh
Central Asia	Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Mongolia, Kyrgyzstan, and Tajikistan

● Requirements:

1. Legitimate citizenship of selected countries in Asia where the Korean Proficiency Test (KPT) is administered.
2. Completed high school or equivalent education prior to starting enrollment at SNUT, with proven academic performance within top 3% of the high schools.
3. Basic knowledge of the spoken and written Korean language (Level 4 or higher in KPT or equivalent)
4. Proficiency in English: CBT TOEFL 200, IELTS 6.0 minimum
5. Recommendation from each government
6. Age below 25

● Course Period and Program

1. Bachelor's Degree: 5 years
(4 years of course work + 1 year of Korean Language Program)
2. Extracurricular programs for foreign students including lectures in Korean cultures, foreign students' meetings, and cultural site visits.

● Scholarships

1. Tuition (subject to 'Terms Regarding Scholarships for Foreign Students' upon admission)
 2. Dormitory (room and meals)
 3. Paid part-time jobs (60 hrs monthly/ 210,000 won)
- *Scholarships do not include airfare and health insurance, etc.

● Procedure
